8. Review of Group Performance for the Fourth Quarter ended June 30, 2009 ("4Q 2009") vs. Fourth Quarter ended June 30, 2008 ("4Q 2008") and the full year ended June 30, 2009 vs. full year ended June 30, 2008.

Revenue

The Group's revenue decreased substantially by S\$6.6 million from S\$13.2 million in 4Q 2008 to S\$6.6 million in 4Q 2009, a decrease of 50.1% as compared to 4Q 2008. The Group's FY 2009 revenue decreased by S\$42.9 million or 57.8% from S\$74.2 million to S\$31.3 million.

This was due to the difficult business environment caused by the global economic turmoil, which resulted in our customers slowing down their business activities. This in turn caused demand for our business to be substantially reduced.

Gross profit

The Group's gross profit declined by S\$1.2 million or 36.3% from S\$3.3 million in 4Q 2008 to S\$2.1 million in 4Q 2009 because of lower revenue, however, the gross margin improved from 25.6% in 4Q 2008 to 32.7% in 4Q 2009. Gross profit declined by S\$11.3million or 51.9% from S\$21.8 million in FY 2008 to S\$10.5 million in FY 2009, however, the gross margin improved from 29.4% in FY 2008 to 33.5% in FY 2009.

The improvement in gross margin was due to changes in products and services mix between our Engineering Services and Burn-In Board Manufacturing and Board Related Products business segments.

Administrative expenses

Administrative expenses decreased by S\$2.9 million or 38.4% from S\$7.6 million in FY 2008 to S\$4.7 million in FY 2009 was due mainly to overall lower business activities, foreign exchange adjustment gain of S\$0.3 million as compared to a loss of S\$0.9 million, lesser depreciation expenses charged and implementation of a shorter work week, cost control and reduction.

Profit for the period/year

Group's net profit declined 29.6% from S\$1.6 million in 4Q 2008 to S\$1.1 million in 4Q 2009. Group's net profit declined by S\$6.5 million, or 54.4% from S\$11.9 million in FY 2008 to S\$5.4 million in FY 2009.

This was due to the recessionary economic climate. Our major customers' business activities have slowed down significantly and this has resulted in overall decrease in revenue.

Group Balance Sheet and Cash Flow Statement – explanation of significant variances

Trade receivables decreased by S\$4.4 million in 4Q 2009 to S\$6.5 million, in line with lower revenue and a better debt collection system in place.

Trade payables decreased by \$\$0.9 million in 4Q 2009 to \$\$1.6 million, due to lower revenue and taking advantage of suppliers' cash rebate incentive for earlier settlement.

Other payables decreased by \$\$2.7 million in 4Q 2009 to \$\$2.2 million, mainly due to lower accruals of staff wages, bonus, incentives and profit sharing scheme.

Cash and cash equivalent increased by S\$1.0 million in 4Q 2009 to S\$51.5 million, due to net cash generated from operating activities of S\$5.9 million which was offset by dividends paid amounting to S\$3.5 million, treasury share buyback of S\$0.6 million and repayment of loans of S\$0.7 million.

10. A commentary at the date of the announcement of the significant trends and competitive conditions of the industry in which the Group operates and any known factors or events that may affect the Group in the next reporting period and the next 12 months.

The recessionary economic climate has eroded consumer and business confidence, and our major customers' business activities have slowed down significantly. While there are tentative signs of improvement, global recovery is expected to be subdued. We expect the difficult economic climate to continue to pose a challenging operating environment for our Group. Our Burn-In and Related Services and Engineering Services and Board Manufacturing Related Products have and will continue to feel the impact of this current global slow down into the near future.

We are continuing to take cost reduction measures while carefully maintaining capacity balance with demands of our customers and to stay competitive. Our focus and business strategies remain clear and we will continue to work closely with our customers to meet their quality and service expectations.

The Group is confident to ride out the current economic downturn. With our healthy balance sheet, very low gearing and strong cash position, we remain alert to new growth opportunities and will explore and seize relevant business opportunities as and when they arise. We will continue to pursue more turnkey based engineering and system integration projects in various markets.
