Notes to the condensed interim consolidated financial statements

N1. Corporate Information

The Company (Registration No. 202002889W) is incorporated in Singapore with its principal place of business and registered office at 19A Serangoon North Avenue 5, Singapore 554859. The Company is listed on the mainboard of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited. These condensed interim consolidated financial statements as at and for the second half and full year ended 30 June 2024 comprise the Company and its subsidiaries (collectively, the "**Group**").

The principal activity of the Company is that of an investment holding company. The principal activities of the subsidiaries consist of the provision of burn-in and related services, design and manufacture of burn-in boards and boards related products, engineering services and equipment distribution, and trading of imaging equipment and energy-efficient products and provision of business support activities.

N2. Basis of Preparation

The condensed interim financial statements as at and for the second half and full year ended 30 June 2024 have been prepared in accordance with SFRS(I) 1-34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Accounting Standards Committee. The condensed interim financial statements do not include all the information required for a complete set of financial statements. However, selected explanatory notes are included to explain events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the Group's financial position and performance of the Group since the last interim financial statements for the period ended 31 December 2023.

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the previous financial year which were prepared in accordance with SFRS(I)s, except for the adoption of new and amended standards as set out in Note 2.1.

The condensed interim consolidated financial statements are presented in Singapore dollar which is the Company's functional currency.

N2.1. New and amended standards adopted by the Group

A number of amendments to Standards have become applicable for the current reporting period. The Group did not have to change its accounting policies or make retrospective adjustments as a result of adopting those standards.

N2.2. Use of judgements and estimates

The significant judgements made by management in applying the Group's accounting policies and the key sources of estimation uncertainty were the same as those that applied to the consolidated financial statements as at and for the year ended 30 June 2023.

No critical judgement was made in the process of applying the Group's accounting policies that would have a significant effect on the amounts recognised in the financial statements.

Estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimates are revised and in any future periods affected.

Information about assumptions and estimation uncertainties that have a significant risk of resulting in a material adjustment to the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities within the next interim period are included in the following notes:

- Note 6 Calculation of loss allowance for trade receivables
- Note 7 Allowance for inventories
- Note 8 Impairment of property, plant and equipment

N3. Segment and revenue information

The Group is primarily engaged in three main operating divisions namely, Burn-In and related services ("Burn-in Services"), Burn-In boards and related products ("Manufacturing and PCBA Services"), and engineering services and equipment distribution ("Engineering"). These operating segments are reported in a manner consistent with internal reporting provided to the chief operating decision-maker who is responsible for allocating resources and assessing the performance of the operating segments.

The Group's businesses are not affected significantly by seasonal or cyclical factors during the financial period.

In 2H 2023, revenue of \$2,286,000 arose from sales to a major customer from the Engineering business segment. These revenues account for approximately 29% (2H 2023: 55%) of the Group's revenue.

Included in revenues of \$25,075,000 (FY 2023: \$34,896,000) is revenue of \$5,444,000 (FY 2023: \$10,046,000) arising from sales to a major customer from the Burn-in Services and Manufacturing and PCBA Services business segments, revenue of \$2,736,000 (FY 2023: \$3,617,000) arising from sales to a major customer from the Manufacturing and PCBA business segment, and revenue of \$4,844,000 (FY 2023: \$6,255,000) arising from sales to a major customer from the Engineering business segment. These revenues account for approximately 52% (FY 2023: 57%) of the Group's revenue.

N6. Calculation of loss allowance for trade receivables

The Group uses a provision matrix to calculate expected credit losses ("ECLs") for trade receivables. The provision rates are based on days past due for groupings of various customer segments that have similar loss patterns. The provision matrix is initially based on the Group's historical observed default rates. The Group will calibrate the matrix to adjust historical credit loss experience with forward-looking information, where appropriate.

At every reporting date, the historically observed default rates are updated and changes in the forward-looking estimates are analysed. The assessment of the correlation between historically observed default rates, forecast economic conditions and ECLs is a significant estimate. The Group's historical credit loss experience and forecast of economic conditions may also not be representative of a customer's actual default in the future. The Group has observed payments from customers continue to be forthcoming and therefore, the Group expects the probability of default to remain low.

The carrying amount of trade receivables of the Group at the end of the reporting period was \$3,671,000 (2023: \$7,443,000).

N7. Allowance for inventories

The Group reviews the carrying value of its inventories so that they are stated at the lower of cost and net realisable value. In assessing net realisable value, management identifies inventories where there has been a significant decline in price or cost, aged inventory items and inventory items that may not be realised as a result of certain events, and estimates the recoverable amount of such inventory based on values at which such inventory items are expected to be realised at the end of the reporting period. Management also reviews the possible future use of the aged inventory items as well as the demand for ongoing production and the ability to sell the products at prices above costs, taking into consideration the general economic conditions and market demand.

The carrying amount of inventories of the Group at the end of the reporting period was \$3,680,000 (2023: \$5,153,000), net of allowance amounting to \$621,000 (2023: \$538,000). The cost of inventories recognised as an expense including allowance made for obsolescence of inventories was \$115,000 (2023: \$224,000).

N8. Impairment of property, plant and equipment

The Group assesses at the end of each reporting period whether property, plant and equipment have any indication of impairment. If there are indicators of impairment, the recoverable amount of property, plant and equipment will be determined based on the higher of value in use calculations or the fair value less costs to sell.

A considerable amount of judgement is required in determining the recoverable amount of the property, plant and equipment, which includes, among other factors, the recent transaction prices for similar assets, the condition, utility, age, wear and tear and/or obsolescence of the property, plant and equipment.

The carrying amount of property, plant and equipment of the Group at the end of the reporting period was \$11,430,000 (2023: \$11,966,000).

Statement of Profit or Loss and Other Comprehensive Income

Revenue

FY 2024 vs. FY 2023

In FY 2024, the Group reported revenue of \$25.1 million, a decrease of \$9.8 million or 28.1% as compared to FY 2023 of \$34.9 million across all business segments. The Burn-In Services business segment registered revenue of \$5.4 million in FY 2024, as compared to revenue of \$6.2 million in FY 2023. The Manufacturing and PCBA Services business segment, which remained as the largest contributor to the Group's revenue, registered revenue of \$12.6 million in FY 2024 as compared to revenue of \$20.3 million in FY 2023. The Engineering Services business segment registered revenue of \$7.1 million in FY 2024, as compared to revenue of \$8.4 million in FY 2023.

2H 2024 vs. 2H 2023

In 2H 2024, the Group reported revenue of \$8.5 million, a decrease of \$8.6 million or 50.7% as compared to 2H 2023 of \$17.1 million across all business segments. The Burn-In Services business segment registered revenue of \$1.7 million in 2H 2024, as compared to revenue of \$2.8 million in 2H 2023. The Manufacturing and PCBA Services business segment, which remained as the largest contributor to the Group's revenue, registered revenue of \$5.3 million in 2H 2024 as compared to revenue of \$10.4 million in 2H 2023. The Engineering Services business segment registered revenue of \$1.5 million in 2H 2024, as compared to revenue of \$3.9 million in 2H 2023.

Gross profit

FY 2024 vs. FY 2023

The Group reported a gross profit of \$6.5 million in FY 2024, a decrease of \$1.5 million or 18.4% as compared to \$8.0 million in FY 2023.

Despite a reduction in gross profit across the comparative periods, the Group achieved an increase in gross profit margin. This improvement was primarily driven by the Engineering Development business segment.

2H 2024 vs. 2H 2023

The Group reported a gross profit of \$1.0 million in 2H 2024, a decrease of \$2.4 million or 70.6% as compared to \$3.4 million in 2H 2023.

The Group reported a decrease in both gross profit and gross profit margin across the comparative periods, attributable to reduced sales across all business segments, which translated into higher underlying fixed costs.

Profit for the period

FY 2024 vs. FY 2023 / 2H 2024 vs. 2H 2023

The Group reported a profit of \$2.8 million for FY 2024 compared to \$3.3 million for FY 2023, with a loss of \$38,000 for 2H 2024 compared to a profit of \$1.2 million for 2H 2023.

The decrease in profit was aligned with the decrease in gross profit.

STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION

The Group's total assets decreased by \$1.8 million or 3.0% from \$59.4 million as at 30 June 2023 to \$57.6 million as at 30 June 2024. The decrease was primarily due to the decrease in cash and bank balances of \$2.4 million, trade and other receivables of \$4.0 million, property, plant and equipment of \$0.5 million as well as inventories of \$1.5 million. The overall decrease was partly offset by the increase in fixed deposits of \$6.6 million.

The Group's total liabilities decreased by \$1.6 million or 20.7% from \$7.7 million as at 30 June 2023 to \$6.1 million as at 30 June 2024. The decrease was primarily due to the decrease in trade and other payables.

The Group had a positive working capital of \$41.0 million as at 30 June 2024 as compared to \$40.6 million as at 30 June 2023.

STATEMENT OF CASH FLOWS

The Group generated net cash from operating activities of \$8.2 million for FY 2024.

Net cash used in investing activities was \$4.8 million, which was mainly attributed to the placement of fixed deposits with financial institutions over three (3)-month tenures. Net cash used in financing activities was \$3.3 million, which was primarily due to the dividend paid.

There was an increase in cash and cash equivalents of \$0.2 million for FY 2024.

The Group closed FY 2024 with cash and cash equivalents of \$8.0 million.

The Company did not make any forecasts and prospect statements in respect of the Group's results for the period ended 30 June 2024. The Group's results for the second half year ended 30 June 2024 were generally in line with the commentary under item 10 of the Group's previous results announcement in respect of the period ended 31 December 2023.

Despite the challenges faced by the industry in FY 2024, the Group maintained profitability through prudent business practices and disciplined financial management. While the industrial outlook remains uncertain, the Group is committed to strengthening its core competencies and enhancing its business operations to drive sustainable performance. Furthermore, the Group will continue to seek growth opportunities through mergers, acquisitions, and partnerships to expand its business and enhance shareholder returns.
